## Table 1 Woodberry Wines

#### Château Montmirail 2017 Gigondas Cuvée de Beauchamp

Blend of 75% grenache, 15% syrah, and 10% mourvèdre sourced from old vines on the upper slopes of Gigondas. This benchmark Rhône red delivers lush yet bright fruit, great balance, and the essence of southern French 'garrigue.' Intensely concentrated, the dark fruit is in no way "cooked," with aromas of black cherry, cassis, blackberry and dried strawberry intertwined with black pepper, olives, and the Rhône Valley's signature herb-and-flower box of garrigue. On the mid-palate, this wine reveals the essence of Rhône mountain fruit. It is ready to enjoy now, but will reach its peak between its 8th and 10th birthday. So, stash a few bottles away in the cold reaches of your cellar. Decant for one hour. Food pairing: Young, it accompanies a good meal on a raised kitchen, game and cheeses; ripe, it accompanies meats in sauces and also cheeses.

#### Château Michel Cazevieille Origine 1922, St Chinian

Michel Cazevieille created Origine 1922 in tribute to his grandfather Paul who moved to Cazedarnes in the early twentieth century on a few small parcels of vines that the Cazevieille family will continue to expand. The castle now has 22 hectares of vineyards that extend on plateaus and clay-limestone hillsides. A blend of 20% syrah, and 80% grenache, aged 12 months in French oak barrels. The nose is dominated by the intense red fruits and enhanced by spicy notes and an earthy/woody touch bringing complexity. On the palate, the wine has rich dark fruits, good grippy texture and a long finish. A great little wine of Languedoc-Roussillon.

#### Domaine du Moulin Mauzac

This sparkling wine is the kind of wine that drives wine geeks wild! This pretty sip from the Gaillac region in Southwest France is produced from the indigenous mauzac grape and its fizzy bubbles are created using the Méthode Ancestrale - an ancient technique for producing sparkling wine that uses cold temperatures to halt the first fermentation. The wine is then bottled, fermentation resumes, and voilà - bubbles are created. The nose is reminiscent of apple cider! Fizzy, fruity, and refreshing; shows lively flavors of fresh peaches, green apples, and a touch of honey. Elegant yet playful, it is a great aperitif and Sunday brunch sip.

#### Domaine Seguinot-Bordet 2017 Chablis Vielles Vignes

100% chardonnay from vines that average 80 to 100 years old. Bright, luminous and limpid. The nose is copious, fresh and expressive. It illustrates its maturity with bright colors, sparkling yellows and shining gold. The taste reveals its powerful nature, rich, charming and elegant. A harmonious combination of powerful richness, earthy accent and tender vivacity. The big, long obviously mineral finish is a perfect illustration of the wine's serious yet charming character.

#### Guilbard Fréres 2018 Vouvray La Lanterne

100% chenin blanc from vineyards in the northern part of the Loire, near the town of Tours in mostly calcareous soils. Nice amber-colored yellow with complex aromas revealing white blossoms. The expression in mouth is plump because of the body and good balance between residual sugars and acidity. It provides this Vouvray a lot of delicacy and a nice roundness in mouth.

#### Krasno 2016 Sauvignonasse, Slovenia

Over the centuries, heroic winegrowers have tenaciously terraced the steep marly slopes below the little village of Krasno to plant their vines. Goriška Brda is the enchanting westernmost region of Slovenia, nestled halfway between the Alps and the Adriatic Sea. This unique land produces distinctly mineral wines, with a character only found in Slovenia's Brda region. The Goriška Brda Wine Cellar, established in 1957 as a cooperative, is still fully owned by local wine growers, preserving viticulture in Brda in all its authenticity – among the vineyards grow fruit, olive and other trees. Vineyard and winemaking knowledge are passed from one generation to the next, and the viticulture practices remain hands-on and very traditional. Sauvignonasse, also known as Friulano, makes some of the most impressive and distinctive wines in Goriska Brda. The Krasno Sauvignonasse is all hand-harvested and fermented in stainless steel and aged in tank for six months on its lees. Brilliant gold in color with pronounced aromatics and wonderful flavors of hazelnut, almond, pear and white flowers. Round, rich and textured with great concentration and a long, intense finish, this stunning Sauvignonasse is a great showcase of this noble varietal in Slovenia

#### Soléna 2016 Chardonnay

There are fresh cherry/berry flavors on palate with wonderful acidity and lightly nuanced oak/cedar notes and brown spice. This is elegant and age worthy. Very limited – just 600 cases produced. #### Tenuta di Angoris 2014 Pignolo

This is a dark-skinned grape native to Friuli, in the northeast of Italy. It has a long-standing reputation for producing deep-colored and high-quality wines that were once popular with the monks of the region's ancient Abbazia (Abbey) di Rosazzo. It is now enjoying a renaissance in Italy, making wines that are tannic, brooding and rich, with blackberry and plum flavors. Structured with cedar box/sandalwood notes. Unique, perfectly balanced with a warm finish.

#### Trinitas Elementis

This bold wine opens with aromatics of bright red fruit, vanilla bean and cocoa. The rich berry filled palate is mouth coating, and trails off with flavors of dark berries/cherries and chocolate. Everyone can use a case of this! WINEMAKER'S NOTES: I was tasked in the middle of harvest with making a red wine that would be ready for market the following spring. My idea was to make it in the style of an early to market Spanish red. I wanted to push bright red fruit and minimize aggressive tannin. So, I picked ripe and didn't over extract. Pump overs were slightly shorter but with maximum O2 and we pressed early. The blend consists of zinfandel (37%), merlot (24%), cabernet franc (16%), carignane (12%), petite sirah (7%), and mataro (7%)."

#### Beyra 2016 Reserva

70% tinta roriz and 30% touriga nacional from vineyards planted in the plateau area of Beira Interior wine region, at an average altitude of 700 meters, growing in schist soils. Vineyards are all of native varieties that are perfectly adapted to environmental and climatic characteristics created by the altitude, chosen one by one depending of the vintage. Spent 8 months in 2/3 American new oak barrels and 1/3 French. Fruity aroma with discreet minerality in balance with barrel aging notes. On palate, rich berries, raisins, spices, subtle notes of vanilla and toast. Fruity and persistent with fresh and elegant aftertaste. Try it with beef roasts, Iberian ham and cheeses. From Portugal's Beira Interior.

#### Bravium 2016 Pinot Noir, Anderson Valley

From the far reaches of Mendocino, this elegant wine is pure and suave. Ruby red color with aromas of strawberry, rhubarb, rose petals, raspberry, wild berry, woodsmoke, damp soil, pine, and red cherry. A soft, juicy entry delivers concentrated berry patch flavors, balanced by sappy and savory whole cluster-derived notes, with medium acidity and a supple, mineral-driven undertone. Fine-grained tannins join spice notes on the creamy, beautifully layered mid-palate. This balanced wine has a great core of red fruit, stellar focus, just enough grip, and a complex finish.

#### 2016 Cashmere Black

These vineyards in the warm growing region of Contra Costa County provide about 95% of the grapes for this dark red blend. Vines planted in sandy-soil and limited rainfall produce grapes of great flavor intensity and dark color. The wine is a blend of petite sirah, zinfandel, mourvèdre, and carignane. Velvety, full-bodied, complex red wine with blueberry, plum and violet aromas with enticing flavors of juicy cherry, vanilla. meat and roasted coffee lead to a rich, lengthy finish.

#### Cline 2017 Viognier, North Coast

Fruity, spicy aromas and flavors of peach cobbler and creme anglaise with a silky, bright, fruity medium body and a smooth, stimulating, medium-long finish that presents nuances of spiced yellow apple, nougat, and nectarine skin with fine, fruit tannins and a suggestion of oak flavor. Bright acidity lifts the mouthfeel for a refreshing, but still rich flavor profile. This is a very tasty, round, well-balanced and satisfying Viognier. Great buy at a tiny price.

#### Domaine de la Solitude 2016 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge

The 2016 vintage in the Southern Rhône was wonderful and this is a great example. This rich blend is 50% grenache, 25% syrah, 10% cinsault, 15% mourvèdre. Nose has a garrigue bouquet, rockrose flowers, anise, and black currants. On palate the wine is full-bodied, creamy, lush, plump with leather and savory notes, leather, red berries and stone fruit. It remains fresh and fruit-driven through the long spice inflected finish. Drink now through 2030. Wine Advocate - 93 Points

#### Domaine de Chevalier 2016 La Petite Lune Bordeaux Blanc

Such a vibrant, fresh, fleshy sauvignon blanc blended meticulously with sémillon by the same team that brings the amazing Domaine de Chevalier Blanc - this is a hidden gem of a white Bordeaux. Fragrant with juicy green apple, clean white flowers, and mouthwatering ripe peach, this is a zingy, richly textured effort from two Bordeaux masters, Olivier Bernard of Domaine de Chevalier and Stéphane Derenoncourt, the sage of Saint-Émilion. The sémillon contributes the richness and texture of the body, while the sauvignon blanc supplies the vibrant acidity and fresh-cut grass and citrus notes. Lip-smacking good.

#### Groth 2018 Sauvignon Blanc

A lovely wine from Napa Valley. Bright tropical and floral aromas (lemon zest, melon, hay) abound. The blend is 86% sauvignon blanc, 14% sémillon co-fermented and partially aged sur-lie. Juicy and pure citrus flavors reflective of the aromas. This is a robust wine with a big lush mouthfeel with good acidity. Well-balanced, it finishes long on the fading palate, with subtle ginger notes.

#### Neyers Vineyards 2016 Chardonnay Carneros District

Rich, smooth, lush, old fashioned chardonnay with a nice toasty note. Crème brûlée at first with juicy citrus acidity for balance. The grapes are whole-cluster pressed, and fermentation was carried out in a mixture of new and used French oak barrels, using native, wild yeast, and periodic lees stirring. Malolactic fermentation also occurs naturally, without the addition of an artificial starter. The additional contact with the yeast lees after barrel fermentation results in a lovely aroma that the French call "Noisette" after the hazelnut character it resembles.

The fruit is organically grown with ripe blackberry, cocoa and mint on the nose. Brambly red berry fruit palate with a tannic grip, finishes with notes of underbrush and licorice. #### Beaucanon Estate 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon

The Beaucanon Estate winery focuses on sustainable and organic methods. Louis de Coninck, the winemaker, originates from France. 89% cabernet sauvignon with 10% petit verdot and 1% malbec Opaque in the glass with a big mouthful of black cherries and blueberries on entry. Dense with medium oak with hints of pepper and spice. Nicely balanced. Outstanding price for Napa juice

#### Berton 2017 The Black Shiraz

A mild summer and cool nights resulted in a long ripening period with good fresh fruit flavors. Fruit was harvested late February to early March in the middle of the night under cool conditions allowing for fresh fruit flavor and minimum oxidation. This vintage stands out with rich, ripe and juicy characteristics with great length and depth of color. This is a bold example of the Australian style Shiraz with deep color and aromas of blackberry and plum with notes of spicy oak. The palate is intense with rich plum, blueberry and mocha notes. The tannins are dense and balanced allowing for great structure and a lengthy finish. From Coonawarra and Padthaway, Australia.

#### Compania Bodeguera de Valenciso Rioja Reserva 2010

Valenciso continues to fashion one of the greatest of all Rioja wines. This 2010 Rioja Reserva is the finest in a string of great Rioja Reservas from this superbly run bodega, but don't just take our word for it. Tim Atkins, Master of Wine, and Decanter magazine awarded the 2010 96 points. The wine is adorned with a deep purple robe, explosive aromatics, finely polished fruit, and captivating spice tones. Produced from 100% tempranillo, it offers savory scents of red and black fruits, ripe woodland berries, sandalwood, cinnamon, and deft touches of vanilla from oak barrel ageing. In the mouth, the wine unfolds slowly and persistently in true Rioja Alta fashion to reveal a wellspring of fruit, spice, and warm wood flavors. Moreover, layers of complex flavors continue to tantalize the palate and linger long after the wine slips down the throat. And once again in 2010, Valenciso's Reserva strikes the ideal balance between fruit and structure, characteristics that have consistently earned international acclaim. We suggest serving the extraordinary wine at cool room temperature (60°-62° F) after an hour or more of aeration. However, there's no need to be in a hurry; this Rioja Reserva will evolve in a glass or decanter for several hours. If stored properly, the 2010 Valenciso Rioja Reserva will continue to mature in bottle and drink beautifully a decade or more from now.

#### Greywacke 2017 Sauvignon Blanc

Forget flamboyant Marlborough sauvignon blanc; this restrained example is a pure and elegant expression sourced from both the Wairau Valley and an elevated site in the upper Awatere. It offers delicate aromas of elderflower, nettles, chamomile and citrus. Light to medium in body, a short period on lees has brought a textural element to the mid-palate, before the fresh but balanced acidity provides a flourish on the finish. Packed with flavor. Always one of Marlborough's top sauvignon blancs, made by former Cloudy Bay winemaker Kevin Judd. A very stylish wine. High scores from Decanter (92) and Vinous (90) From New Zealand.

#### Hauner Hierà 2016 Terre Siciliane IGT

The fruit comes from the Aolian Islands just off the north coast of Sicily. It is a blend of indigenous grapes: nero d'avola, alicante and nocera. Medium weight with a rich, fragrant bouquet of dark, wild berries, sweet spice, tobacco and chocolate along with earthy notes characteristic of dry soil. This is velvety, complex, with smooth tannins, fresh, fruity flavors, fennel dust, balsamic notes and acidity. Maintains wonderful balance and a luscious, bright style.

#### La Spinetta 2015 Barbera Ca di Pian

Sourced from younger vines grown in two sites: Castagnole and Costigliole. The vines are 6-20 years old and grow on calcareous soil at 300 meters above sea level, at a southern exposure. Harvest usually happens in the last week September to early October, after which time, the grapes are fermented in rotofermenters for 6 to 7 days. The wine then ages for 12 months in a mix of new and old, medium toasted, French oak barrique. Malolactic fermentation takes place in the barrique. The Ca di Pian Barbera is aged for another two months in bottle before its release. The 2015 Barbera d'Asti Ca' di Pian is bold, plump and juicy, all qualities that make it an excellent choice for drinking now and over the next few years. Dark blue and purplish berry fruit, chocolate, spice and new leather are all pushed forward in this pretty great value from an outstanding producer.

#### Lavau 2016 Châteauneuf du Pape

From a fabulous vintage in the historic village between the towns of Orange and Avignon, in France's southern Rhône Valley. This is a blend of 50% grenache, 40% syrah and 10% mourvèdre from vines that are on average, 40 years of age. The terroir is sandy soils found in the Baratin vineyard. The grapes are 100% destemmed. The wine is aged in a combination of 50% new, French oak barrels and the remaining 50% of the wine is aged in tank for 12 months before bottling. Medium bodied, early drinking wine with a forward, red berry core of fruit. Amazing price!

#### Domaine Raffault 2017 Chinon Rouge

The fruit for Domaine Jean-Maurice Raffault's Chinon Rouge comes from vineyards on sandy, alluvial soil near the Vienne River. This origin gives a supple, fruity Chinon that is perfect for early drinking. The wine's dark cherry and raspberry flavors are best appreciated with a slight chill. The wine also has a bit of earthiness, a touch of cocoa dust and mineral that appears midpalate through finish. Raffault's Chinons are wonderfully expressive wines that go harmonize with a wide variety of classic French dishes, while their natural fruity acidities make them fine matches for Asiatic cuisine, grilled fish, and spicy American foods. For wines of such depth and complexity, they also represent remarkable value.

#### Supremus Toscana IGT 2013

Delicious blend from the Maremma of 75% sangiovese, 15% merlot, and 10% cabernet sauvignon. Aged in oak barrels and barriques 14 months followed by six months of bottle aging. Has an intense nose with nuances of violet, red berries, cherries, vanilla, leather, espresso and chocolate. On the palate, a core of dark cherry fruit in this nicely layered, inviting red. Powerful finish.

#### Viña Reboreda 2016 Godello

100% Godello from 40-year-old vines planted in chalky-clay soils on steep slopes overlooking the Miño River in the D.O. of Ribeiro. Pale, brilliant yellow-gold. Spicy and focused on the clean, medium-bodied palate, offering incisive Meyer lemon, melon and quince flavors and a deeper touch of honey that emerges on the back half. ## Table 4 Rocca di Montegrossi

Rocca di Montegrossi is located in the heart of Chianti Classico – just outside Monti in Chianti, about 7 kilometers from Gaiole. Marco Ricasoli-Firidolfi, is a descendant of the historic winemaking family that can be credited with having put Chianti on the map of the world's best wines. The winery, whose restoration and modernization were completed in 2000, is located near the Romanesque Church of San Marcellino. Welcome Marco!

#### Rocca di Montegrossi 2017 Chianti Classico

A blend of 85% sangiovese, with canaiolo and colorino. This is the estate's flagship wine. Aging takes place mainly in large casks and barrels made with Allier oak for 12 months. Wine is bottled unfiltered and rests in bottle for 6 months prior to release. In the glass it is lively ruby, with bright violet reflections, and on the nose displays the rich fruity aromas typical of the varietals, particularly forest berry fruit and sour cherries. On the palate it is harmonious and well structured, with nice tannins and savory notes.

#### Rocca di Montegrossi 2015 Geremia

A powerful, intense wine that also displays elegance and balance, bringing out the character of the terroir. Intense ruby, with violet nail, and with complex aromas that bring to mind sour cherries, currants and other wild berry fruit, mingled with licorice and vanilla. A wine of great structure and complexity, with a core of black fruits on the palate is plush, soft and velvety, thanks to its richness and the perfect ripeness and integration of the tannins. #### Abbazia di Novacella 2018 Kerner

#### CHATEAU JEAN de BEL AIR 2015 BORDEAUX—GOLD MEDAL PARIS

Owned by Betrand Gonzales the Chateau is located in Sauveterre de Guyenne in the far eastern edge of the Entre-deux-Mers. The Chateau Jean de Bel Air is composed of 60% merlot and 40% cabernet sauvignon. Its beautiful color reveals its concentration and richness, and aromas of black fruits. It is a balanced wine with strong tannins.

#### CHATEAU CHAUVET 2015 BORDEAUX—GOLD MEDAL LYON
