A semi-dry, purple-tinged red wine with intense cherry/pomegranate fruit. Tart entry with some richness mid-palate and good acidity all the way through. A pleasant accompaniment to spicy food or when you crave a touch of sweetness. Excellent as an aperitif, or paired with salami, tagliatelle with ragù, or pastries such as sour cherry tart. Klaus Lentsch is committed to low yields and high quality. the vineyards are situated at 400-600 m above sea level on sunny steep terraces, and planted in clay and gravelly soils. These conditions along with commitment to sustainable farming and production methods make for enjoyable, high quality wines of delicious freshness and fruitiness. The color is luminous pale yellow with a greenish glow. The perfumed nose is fresh and racy, reminiscent of green apples and meadow blossoms. On the palate it is full, clean, refreshing and lively with a surprising and impressive body with floral notes and exotic fruit nuances (star fruit?).
